



Care instructions for real wood veneer and varnished solid wood

Material description

We process wood which is grown in nature. These usually have small irregularities in structure and color. You can shape the face of each piece, in order to testify to their authenticity.

In order to preserve the good properties and the beauty of the real wood for as long as possible, the surface is protected with a varnish layer. This protects the surface from the harmful effects of alcohol, household chemicals, moisture and grease.

How to clean lacquered wood?

Natural wood should be cautiously maintained. Clean your wood product with a slightly damp (never wet) cloth in the direction of the wood fiber. Then rub the surface with a soft, dry cloth.

Caution: The natural wood product must not be left moist or wet for a long period of time, be it in the care or during use. Always remove water splashes immediately and dry the surface.

What detergents should be used?

For regular maintenance, use a damp cloth. In case of a heavy soiling, dilute soapy water can be used. Then wipe and dry the surface with a soft cloth.

Caution: Never use acidic detergents, bleaches, furniture polish, polishing agents, detergents, abrasive cleaners or steam cleaners.

Commercially advertised paints should not be used for varnished wood. These make it shiny, but also reduce the resistance properties.
